Criteria to Applicants

- Applicants shall form teams with <u>maximum 5 members</u> from the <u>same</u> <u>university</u> nominating the teams
- Only 3 members in each team could join the Entrepreneurship Boot Camp overseas.
- Principal applicant of the team must be a HK Permanent ID Card holder
- Between the age of 18 and 30
- Undergraduates or postgraduates
- Currently enrolled in or have graduated within 3 years
- Projects must be on FinTech
